Old Business

Tenaris – Josh Konecheck

- Water on SR 351 Josh Konecheck of Tenaris phoned to say that they will make preparations to address the water running on the road near the bridge. A repair date is tentative on November 16. Also, reported on October 9 a leak from a contractor's storage tank leaked and the DEP was involved and cleanup was to both's satisfaction.
- The pledge to donate \$15,000 for the Koppel Park; \$7,500 this year and \$7,500 next year. Waiting to hear when the donation will be sent.
- Use of street sweeper was discussed both as contracted use by them or Koppel Borough sweeping their lot.
