PARKING ORDINANCE ON STREETS

ORDINANCE NO. 221

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING PARKING REGULATIONS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THEIR VIOLATION IN THE BOROUGH OF KOPPEL, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Town Council of the Borough of Koppel, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. Parking Prohibited at Certain Locations.

Parking shall be prohibited at all times in the following locations:

- (a) On the following streets or portions thereof:
- 1. On the northerly and southerly sides of Arthur Street to the Pittsburgh and Ashtabula Railway.
- 2. On the easterly side of Third Avenue from Arthur Street to Richard Street.
- 3. On the southerly side of Mount Street from Fourth Avenue to Fifth Avenue.
- 4. On the northerly and southerly sides of Mount Street from Fifth Avenue to Sixth Avenue.

SECTION 2. Thirty minute Parking Zones.

Parking shall be limited to thirty (30) minutes

in the following locations:

- 1. On the northerly and southerly sides of Arthur Street from Fourth Avenue to Lemon Alley.
- 2. On the easterly and westerly sides of Fifth Avenue from Ida Street to Mount Street.
- 3. On the westerly side of Third Avenue from Mount Street proceeding north, a distance of sixty (60) feet.

SECTION 3. Fifteen Minute Parking Zone.

Parking shall be limited to fifteen (15) minutes

in the following locations:

1. On the northern and southern side of Arthur Street from Lemon Alley to Fifth Avenue.

SECTION 4. Penalty for Violation.

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than two dollars (\$2.00) or more than ten dollars (\$10.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs to imprisonment in County Jail for not more than five (5) days.
