

ORDINANCE NO 27.

An ordinance making it unlawful for any person to keep any dog or dogs within the limits of the Borough of Koppel without paying a license as hereinafter provided and without keeping a license tax attached to said dog as hereinafter provided and providing for the detention of all dogs running loose upon any street, lane or alley without said license tax attached and imposing a penalty upon any person claiming any dog so detained and providing for the disposal of all dogs not claimed.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Koppel, a municipal corporation of the County of Beaver, State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained by authority of the same.

Section I. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to keep any dog within the limits of the Borough of Koppel, without paying the license fee hereinafter provided and without keeping a license tag attached to said dog as hereinafter provided.

Section II. That the license fee above mentioned shall be as follows:

1st. For each male dog one dollar per year.

2nd. For each female dog ~~five~~ six dollars per year.

Section III. That upon payment of said license fee to the Secretary of the Council the said Secretary shall enter the name of the person taking out said license upon a register to be by him kept and shall deliver to said person a license tag for each license fee paid on which the year for which the license is paid shall be stamped.

Section IV. All license tags issued in the year 1914

shall have stamped on them the figures 1914 and shall be good until the 1st day of January, 1915.

Section V. All licenses issued except those issued in 1914, shall be good until the 1st day of the year next after the license is issued.

Section VI. Any dog found loose upon any street, lane or alley of the Borough of Koppel, without a license tag attached to it shall be taken and detained for twenty-four hours.

Section VII. Any person claiming any dog detained as aforesaid, before it is delivered to such person, shall pay the license fee above provided and in addition thereto shall pay a penalty of two dollars for each dog claimed.

Section VIII. All dogs detained for twenty-four hours and not claimed and the license and penalty above provided paid by the person claiming, shall be killed.

Section IX. Out of the fee above mentioned the Secretary of the Council shall be paid twenty-five cents for each license by him issued.

Section X. The officer taking, caring for, killing and burying any dog under this ordinance shall be paid out of the treasury of the Borough the sum of one dollar.

Section XI. The officer performing the service above mentioned shall be paid the said sum of one dollar though the dog has been claimed and the license and penalty paid as above provided.

Enacted and ordained into an ordinance this 12 day of May 1914.
