

ORDINANCE NO 32

An Ordinance prohibiting the running at large of chickens, ducks, turkeys, geese and all other fowls within the limits of the Borough of Koppel, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and providing penalties for the violation hereof.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Koppel, a municipal corporation of the County of Beaver and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. From and after the passage and promulgation of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for chickens, ducks, turkeys, geese and all other fowls to run at large within the limits of the Borough of Koppel, Beaver County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 2. The owner or owners of any chickens, ducks, turkeys, geese or other fowls, or any of them, shall, upon conviction of having permitted any chickens, ducks, turkeys geese or other fowls to run at large within the limits of the Borough of Koppel, before the Bruggess of said Borough, or any Justice of the Peace, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$5.00 and costs, or shall be imprisoned in the lockup of said Borough for a period not exceeding forty-eight hours, or either, in the discretion of the magistrate.

Provided, however, that no prosecution shall be instituted under this ordinance unless twenty-four hours notice shall have been given to such owner or owners, and if, within that period, the said owner or owners shall cease violating this ordinance, then no information shall be entertained for its violation.

Provided further, however, that any owner or owners who shall have been given the notice as above provided, shall not be entitled to a notice in case of a second violation of said ordinance, but in such case the information may be made without the twenty-four hours notice above provided for.

Provided further that this ordinance shall be enforced only on the formal written complaint of a citizen.
