

ORDINANCE NO 4 .

An ordinance prohibiting the running at large of horses, cows, and other animals in the Borough of Koppel.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Koppel, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same as follows.

SECTION 1. That from and after the passage of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for the owner or owners of any horse, mare, mule, swine, cow, sheep, or goat to permit the same to run at large or to tie out or tether the same on any street, avenue, alley, highway or open land within the limits of the Borough of Koppel.

SECTION 2. It shall be the duty of the high Constable, Street Commissioner or such other person as the Town Council may appoint for that purpose, to seize and impound any such animal that may be found running at large or tethered on any street, avenue, lane, alley or highways or any open land within the limits of said Borough, and there keep the same until ordered by the Burgess of said Borough to deliver said animal to the owner thereof.

SECTION 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof before the Burgess or any Justice of the Peace, forfeit and pay for the use of the Borough, a fine of not less than \$20.00, together with the sum of 50¢ additional for each animal seized and impounded, which said sum of 50¢ for each animal so seized and impounded shall be paid to the officer making said seizure, in addition to the regular costs allowed such officer.
