AN ORDINANCE of the Borough of Koppel, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, forbidding the accumulation of debris, rubbish, refuse or garbage upon private property, or encumbering the same with growth of weeds, brush or briars in the Borough of Koppel, Pennsylvania, and declaring the same to be a public nuisance, and providing for the abatement of such nuisance and imposing a penalty for the violation of the same.

WHEREAS, the growth of weeds, brush or briars, or any accumulation of debris, rubbish, refuse or any garbage upon private property within the limits of the borough, are unsightly, unsanitary, injurious to health, and generally objectionable to the residents thereof, and interfere with the orderly development of the said Borough and enjoyment of life by the residents thereof, and constitute a public nuisance in the said Borough, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Borough of Koppel, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that it shall be unlawful for the owner or owners of any private property within the limits of the Borough of Koppel, or any resident thereof having possession or control of private property, whether such resident owns the said property or not, to permit any growth of weeds, brush or briars, or any accumulation of debris, rubbish, refuse or garbage on any private property owned by such person or persons, or in his possession or control, and any such person or persons, permitting any growth of weeds, brush or briars, or any accumulation of debris, rubbish, refuse or garbage on his, her or its property within the limits of the said Borough shall be guilty of maintaining a public nuisance, and on conviction thereof before the burgess of the said borough or a Justice of the Peace, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding

Borough shall be guilty of maintaining a public nuisance, and on conviction thereof before the burgess of the said borough or a Justice of the Peace, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding Ten (\$10.00) Dollars for each offense, and costs of prosecution,

and in default of payment of said fine and costs, shall be sentenced to imprisonment in the Borough lockup for a period not exceeding five days, or in the jail of the County of Beaver not exceeding thirty days, at the discretion of the Magistrate imposing the fine.

SECTION 2. It shall be the duty of the owner or owners of such property, or the person or persons in possession and control thereof, within five days of the receipt of notice from the Burgess or any police officer of the said Borough, who are hereby required to enforce the provisions hereof, to remove from any property owned by or in possession of such persons, all growth of weeds, brush, briars, and all accumulation of debris, rubbish, refuse and garbage and to abate the said nuisance, and place the said property in a proper and sanitary condition, and if any owner or owners of such property, or person or persons in possession and control thereof, shall refuse to abate said public nuisance within five days from receipt of notice to abate the same as aforesaid then such nuisance shall be abated by the street commissioner of the said Borough, or other employee thereof, by direction of the Burgess or council of the said Borough, and the cost and expense of abating such nuisance shall be collected from the Borough of Koppel against the same, as provided by the law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. for the

same as aforesaid then such nuisance shall be abated by the street commissioner of the said Borough, or other employee thereof, by direction of the Burgess or council of the said Borough, and the cost and expense of abating such nuisance shall be collected from the Borough of Koppel against the same, as provided by the law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, for the collection of the same and expense of abating public nuisances.
