

ORDINANCE NO 12.

Ordinance prohibiting the defacing of buildings, poles, fences etc. by posting bills, placards, etc., thereon, without the consent of the owner thereof.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Koppel, and it is hereby enacted by authority of the same.

SECTION 1. That from and after the passage of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to daub paint, paint advertisements or post placards upon or otherwise deface the walls of any building, house or the fence around the yard or yards connected therewith, or any fence surrounding any vacant lot or lots, without the consent of the owner or owners, or if any person shall daub paint, paint advertisements or post placards upon or otherwise deface lamp posts, fire plugs, telegraph or telephone poles, trees or tree-boxes, or shall cause the same to be done by others, such person or persons shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. Any person violating Section 1 of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction before the Byrgess or any Justice of the Peace, forfeit and pay for the use of the Borough a fine not exceeding \$10 and in default of payment thereof, may be committed to the County Jail for a period not exceeding thirty days.
