

An ordinance prohibiting the breaking down or hitching of horses, mules or other animals to growing trees on the streets, avenues, alleys or highways within the Borough of Koppel.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Koppel and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. That on and after the passage of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to wilfully break down any trees growing on any of the streets, avenues, alleys or highways within said Borough or otherwise injure or destroy the same or who shall hitch any horse, mule or other animal to any growing tree or tree box erected for the protection of any growing trees within the limits of the Borough aforesaid.

SECTION 2. Any person violating Section 1 of this ordinance shall, upon conviction before the Burgess or any Justice of the Peace, forfeit and pay for the use of the Borough a fine of not more than \$10 and costs, and in default of payment thereof, be committed to the County Jail for a period not exceeding thirty days.
